Explanation of programs and services:

The Nurturing Fathers Program

This is a 13-week evidence-based program. It helps fathers build nurturing skills, strengthen their bonds with their children, and cultivate positive parenting attitudes and behavior.

Grandparent/Kin Support Group

Provides information/resources to grandparents/kinship raising their grandchildren.

Game Changers

An after-school program for youth ages 10 up. Activities include arts & crafts, games, conversations about bullying, safety, mindful journaling, and movie nights!
