#### Co-Parenting

The overall emphasis of *Cooperative Parenting and Divorce* is to offer children of divorce the opportunity to grow in a home environment free from being caught in the middle of their parents' hostility. The goals of this program are to:

Assist parents in shifting their role from former spouses to co-parents

Educate parents regarding the impact of parental conflict on their child's development

Help parents identify their contribution to conflict while increasing impulse control

Teach parents anger management, communication and conflict-resolution skills

Educate parents about children's issues in divorce

### Parenting Journey

This is a 12 weeks program. Its mission is to create safer, more resilient families by supporting them in developing their inner strengths, life skills, and network of resources they need to succeed. Parents who have found value in the program are parents who struggle to manage personal and professional obligations, come from diverse social, cultural, and economic backgrounds, have experienced violence or childhood trauma, in recovery, experience mental health issues, or are working to regain custody of their children.

- YEP (Youth Empowerment Program)
   After school program for middle schoolers
- YLP (Youth Leadership Program)
  After school program for high schoolers
- TWW (Teen Writing Workshop)
  A writing and drawing program for youths 13yrs-19yrs
- Parenting Together
   Parent support group
- Grandparents Raising Grandchildren
   Support group for grandparents that are raising their grandchildren

All programs are free and open to all.
